
THIS ORDER IS ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS


- Approval is hereby granted as provided in Article 6 of Regulation I of the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency to the applicant to install or establish the equipment, device or process described hereon at the INSTALLATION ADDRESS in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the Engineering Division of the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency.
- This approval does not relieve the applicant or owner of any requirement of any other governmental agency.
- Where high, mid, and low pentane containing expandable beads are defined as 6.5%, 4.5% and 3.5% pentane by weight in the bead, Premier Industries Inc shall limit high and mid level bead use on a calendar year basis under the following schedule:
 - During calendar year 2001, no greater than 40% of foam output shall use high pentane beads and no greater than 30% of foam output shall use mid pentane beads, and;
 - By January 1, 2003, use of high pentane beads shall not exceed 30% of foam output, and;
 - By February 1, 2005, use of high pentane beads shall not exceed 20% of foam output, and;
 - By February 1, 2007, use of high pentane beads shall not exceed 5% of foam output.
- Premier Industries Inc shall maintain monthly records of pentane containing expandable bead usage and annual summaries onsite. These records shall be made available by mail when requested by the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency or on site when requested by Agency personnel conducting inspections.

APPEAL RIGHTS

Pursuant to Puget Sound Clean Air Agency's Regulation I, Section 3.17 and RCW 43.21B.310, this Order may be appealed to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB). To appeal to the PCHB, a written notice of appeal must be filed with the PCHB and a copy served upon Puget Sound Clean Air Agency within 30 days of the date the applicant receives this Order.

LIMITS

1. Western Insulfoam Corp/Premier Pkg. shall limit plant-wide air emissions of the VOC Pentane to 99 tons during any 12 consecutive months after the date of this Order.

This Order is issued with the following monitoring, record keeping and reporting requirements and conditions. Pursuant to RCW 43.21B.310, this Order may be appealed to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB). To appeal to the PCHB, an appeal must be filed with the PCHB and a copy served upon PSAPCA within 30 days of receiving this Order.

CONDITIONS

1. Western Insulfoam Corp/Premier Pkg. shall maintain a running 12-month record of the amount of usage of materials containing Pentane. The emissions of Pentane shall be calculated by multiplying the pounds of resin used by 0.045 and then dividing by 2000 lbs per ton.
2. All records of Pentane emissions shall be made available to PSAPCA personnel upon request.
3. Western Insulfoam Corp/Premier Pkg. shall report to PSAPCA with its annual emission statement all periods that exceed the above limits.




