The Puget Sound Clean Air Agency is issuing a final Order of Approval for the proposed mid-kiln firing of whole tires as a fuel substitution for the cement kiln operation. This approval is temporary as described in the approval conditions. Public comments submitted in writing to the Agency and those received orally at the public hearing have been considered and revisions were made to the originally proposed permit conditions in response to those comments.

To appeal to the PCHB, a written notice of appeal must be filed with the PCHB and a copy served upon the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency within 30 days of the date you receive this Order.
